

She was small, almost petite. The cool September wind of Launceston ruffled her tiny frame, but did not daunt her one bit. This was a day when history held its breath. Suddenly, Miss Currie hurried forward, skipped, hopped, missed her footing, leapt again, joyfully soaring into the waiting wide blue yonder.

For the year was 1932, and Miss Currie was a tiny airplane, making one of the first commercial flights in our history. Destination: Flinders Island, 108 miles away over the turbulent waters of Bass Strait. Flying time: 1½ hours.

Australian singers abroad have made their country famous for vocal and musical ability. Yet in Australia itself there has been no permanent opera company, little chance for a singer to earn his living on the stage or to learn his craft in conditions of moderate security.

The liberality of the public, and of the Federal and State Governments, together with the generosity of the Australian Broadcasting Commission and the ready co-operation of J. C. Williamson Theatres Limited, have made it possible for the Australian Elizabethan Theatre to seek a remedy for this situation. HALLMARK OF QUALITY

Sena Jurinac, who is recognised as one of the world's greatest Mozart sopranos received her initial musical training at the Zagreb Musical Academy. The daughter of a Croatian doctor of medicine and a Viennese mother, born at Trevnik, Yugoslavia, in 1921, the singer made her debut at Zagreb State Theatre as Mimi in La Boheme in 1942. Since her audition for Dr. Karl Bohm in 1944 she has been a regular member of the Vienna State Opera Company. Apart from her work in Vienna, Sena Jurinac has sung at the Salzburg Festival, at La Scala, and at Glyndebourne every season since 1949. Madame Jurinac, whose time is divided between commitments at Vienna, Glyndebourne and Italy, plans to visit the United States and Japan in the near future.





Sesto Bruscantini, whose singing career began in 1945 when he entered and won first prize in an Italian radio competition, was destined as the son of a lawyer to follow his father's career, and he did in fact graduate as a Doctor of Law. Signor Bruscantini's singing debut, under the guidance of Maestro Rossi, was made at La Scala in the "Matrimonio Segreto."

Since 1945, Sesto Bruscantini's voice has been heard in Italy, where he is a very well-known and popular artist.

In addition to appearing at the Salzburg Festival as Don Pasquale he has sung numerous roles at Glyndebourne, including Figaro, the Barber, Don Alfonso, Guglielmo and Dandini in Cenerantola.

The lovely opera house at Glyndebourne has many memories for Signor Bruscantini as it was the meeting place for him and Sena Jurinac who have been married for three years.

Dennis Arundell

DENNIS ARUNDELL (Producer—"Marriage of Figaro", "Don Giovanni"). One of England's leading producers and theatrical personalities, Dennis Arundell's versatility is such that he has produced opera, acted, written scripts, composed, translated, lectured and conducted. At Sadler's Wells he has produced some 10 operas. Recent first performances to his credit are Hofmannstahl's "Everyman", with Sibelius' music (this he translated and conducted) and the world premieres of Arthur Benjamin's two operas, "Tale of Two Cities" and "Prima Donna". He has produced two operas under the baton of Sir Thomas Beecham; one, "The Bohemian Girl" at Covent Garden for the first Festival of Britain, in a version prepared by Sir Thomas and himself; the other, Delius' "Irmelin". In Finland, he produced the Finnish National Opera Company in Benjamin Britten's "Peter Grimes". For film producer, Michael Powell (of Pressburger and Powell fame), he translated "Tales of Hoffman" and "Oh, Rosalinda". He directed the opera sequence in the film, "Melba", which has been seen in Australia.

STEFAN HAAG (Producer—"Magic Flute", "Cosi Fan Tutte"). Since his arrival in Australia in 1939, as a member of the Vienna Boys' Choir, Stefan Haag has achieved distinction as a producer of opera. His production of "The Consul" in Melbourne, for the National Theatre Movement three years ago, created theatrical history. He also produced "Tosca", and "Cosi Fan Tutte" for a successful tour of the Commonwealth before leaving to further his studies of Opera in Europe. Since his return to Australia he has been production manager for "Kismet" and has now joined the Elizabethan Theatre Trust as a producer and production director for the Australian Opera Company's Mozart season.



THE MAGIC FLUTE

In Act One, Tamino, a prince from far-off lands, is discovered being pursued by a serpent. Three ladies, the attendants to the Queen of the Night, come to his aid. While they report to the Queen, Tamino, who has recovered, makes acquaintance with the birdcatcher, Papageno, who claims to have strangled the serpent himself. The three ladies return and, as a punishment for lying, lock the lips of Papageno. They also give Tamino a picture of Pamina, the Queen's daughter, who has been kidnapped by Sarastro. As a result, Tamino falls in love with Pamina and is implored by the Queen to rescue her. He is given a magic flute to protect him from harm, and Papageno, who agrees to accompany him, is presented with a set of magic bells, with similar qualities.

Papageno, having arrived in Sarastro's realm, finds Pamina at the mercy of Monostatos, a lecherous Moor. He rescues her and they go in search of Tamino who, in the meantime, has learned that Sarastro is a disciple of truth and righteousness. Pamina and Papageno are prevented in their attempts to escape and, with Tamino, are brought before Sarastro, who orders them to undergo the trials of initiation into his realm.

In Act Two, the story unfolds with Tamino being accepted as a candidate for the priesthood. Tamino and Papageno start their probation by having to observe strict silence towards women. The three ladies appear and try to entice Tamino to return to the Queen of the Night, but he keeps his vow of silence. The Queen then attempts to change the situation by appearing to Pamina and ordering her to kill Sarastro. The sly and stealthy Moor, having overheard them, tries to blackmail Pamina into loving him but Sarastro intervenes and enlightens Pamina on the moral issues involved. Papageno grows tired of the probationary period, despite a promise of a wife, but Tamino keeps his promise, resisting even Pamina's entreaties and tears. Sarastro tells Tamino and Pamina that eventually they will be united. Papageno then has a glimpse of his intended wife. Pamina, overwhelmed by events, attempts suicide. The time for the final test, that of fire and water, has come and Pamina joins Tamino in the ordeal. Both are protected by the magic flute and they emerge triumphantly. In the meantime, Papageno has searched in vain for his Papagena and he also contemplates suicide. However, his magic bells come to his aid and he is united with her.

In a last and desperate attempt to overthrow Sarastro, the Queen, her three ladies and the traitor Monostatos, penetrate the temple, only to be destroyed by the light of Truth and Righteousness.

In the final tableau, the assembled priesthood sees Tamino and Pamina united and accepted into the realm of Sarastro. Papageno, too, has attained the heights of his ambitions—Papagena.
